Youth Services

Government Youth Programs:

Ontario Youth Employment Fund

If you are unemployed, not in school full-time and between 15 and 29, Ontario will do more to help you connect with employers and get a job placement of four to six months.

Ontario: Summer Jobs for Students

For Students: 15-30 years old, who are planning to return to school in the fall. Students: 15 - 18 years old, in select communities. Aboriginal students: 15-24 years old, and up to 29 years old if you have a disability.

Eligibility Criteria

Summer Employment Opportunities (SEO) Program at the Ministry of Natural Resources

Summer Employment Opportunities: full-time, temporary positions ranging from 7 – 16 weeks between May and Labour Day.

MNRF Internship Program

MNRF Interns can participate in a maximum of two 40-week placements. Interns also receive comprehensive career development training and career coaching.

Ontario Internship Program

The Ontario Internship Program offers two one-year paid contracts in a wide range of ministries and agencies across the Ontario Public Service. This is an Entry Level Program.

Eligibility Criteria

Summer Company - Ontario Ministry of Economic Development and Trade

1. Start-up money to kick-off a new summer business 2. Advice and mentorship from local business leaders to help get the business up and running.

Federal Student Work Experience Program

The Federal Student Work Experience Program provides full time students valuable, hands on work experience related to their field of study.

The Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) is a School to Work program that opens the door for students to explore and work in apprenticeship occupations starting in Grade 11 or Grade 12 through the Cooperative Education program.
