Desired Qualifications:

- Demonstrated interest in the mission and vision of the organization
- Awareness of women's issues and sensitivity to diverse cultures
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to work as a team with like-minded individuals

Time Commitment:

Current Board members dedicate an average of 5-10 hours a month to Board meetings and committees and are expected to attend monthly Board meetings. All Board members are required to participate in some form of fund generating activities.
